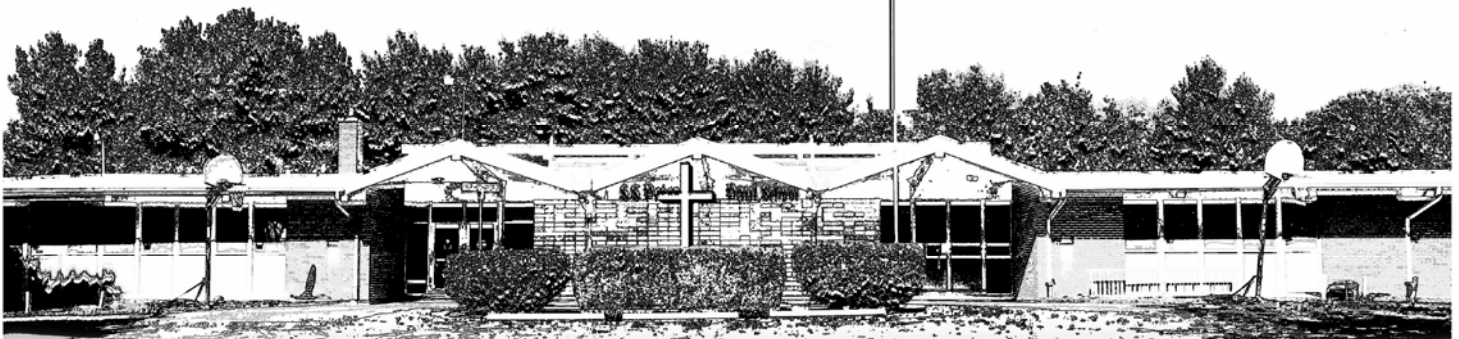

The title of an old song (Barry Manilow, I think!) happens to be a good description of Holy Archangels Parish as we head into the month of August. Our Finance Council resumes on Tuesday, August 25, and our Pastoral Council will meet on Wednesday, August 26. The conclusion of budgets according to "the old way" of doing things is near; our unified budget, already in operation, will not be competing with the old charting of accounts. (Working on both of them at the same time has been tedious and frustrating.) The sale of St. Mary's Hamilton property and buildings to the Hamilton Park District is, for all practical purposes, complete: we've been waiting on some paperwork to make things official for a while. The transaction for Sacred Heart's Dallas City parking lot and Fr. Schramm Hall is complete. The sale of both the Sacred Heart Dallas City Church and the Sacred Heart Warsaw Rectory is still in process. There's a mammoth file of four years of Growing Disciples documents that are about to be a part of our archives.

Our unity as a parish with three church sites and a school is present and ever coming along. But things are fragile, delicate. We understand the change of thinking and envisioning involved in becoming more and more the Holy Archangels Parish. Our continuing thanks for your patience, your devotion, and your dedication to our churches and our school. Fr. T.

About the New Hymnals.... We don't want you to think we're throwing money away! The Oregon Catholic Press Breaking Bread Hymnal is being sent to us at a 70% discount, because we're getting this year's edition. Along with Angel Garcia, one of this year's Totus Tuus Missionaries, Ethan Herrman, will be here from August 12 to August 14. You might want to look him up while he's here, too! Looks like the good news about Hancock County is catching on!

NO SPANISH MASS IN AUGUST According to our usual schedule, Spanish Mass would be August 9. But there won't be a Spanish Mass in August. It will resume in September, with a guest priest fluent in the Spanish language. (Fr. Tony will be with the Spanish Mass Choir in September.)

HEALING SERVICE, with the Sacraments of the Anointing of the Sick and Penance, the ministry of Mr. Roger Shaner, and intercessory prayer to Blessed Fulton Sheen, will take place on Saturday, August 15, after the 4 p.m. Mass at ICC.

ST. NICHOLAS CHARITY ON WHEELS is a ministry of Catholic Charities serving over 900 families in need monthly across the Peoria Diocese.
