Ask Father...

Q: How is St. Michael the Archangel a saint and an angel?

A: To answer this question, we must first define the word "saint". Saint comes from the Latin word *sanctus*, which means "holy one". The Greek equivalent *hagios* means "sanctified", "set apart", or simply "holy". Because Michael is an angel (Gr. *angelos*, which means "messenger") who is in heaven, he is "holy". As an archangel, he has a specific/extraordinary mission, which is to defend Christ's Church on earth from the Evil One. Therefore, Michael is both a saint ("holy") and an angel ("messenger").

The title of "Saint" was given to him since the fourth century by popular acclaim, although he has never been formally declared a saint.

Michael (Hb. *Mikha'el*) means "Who is as God?" or "Who is like God?" His name is a battle cry and was used by the good angels who fought alongside Michael when driving out Satan and the fallen angels from Heaven.

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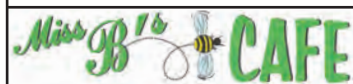
